She was responsible for and worked closely with her legal team and management on Securities Exchange Commission (SEC) and NASDAQ matters including shareholder meetings, periodic reports and filings, corporate governance and compensation matters. Heidy also provided legal support for business partners in all Sarepta departments on key projects including drafting, commenting on or negotiating contracts, policies, communications and documents for external and internal use. She was also on Sarepta's promotional review committee, medical review committee, 401(K) committee and the sponsorship and grants committees. Heidy was the legal lead in Sarepta's commercial readiness working group (responsible for negotiating and finalizing key commercial contracts and developing Sarepta's commercial compliance program and policies). Throughout 2017, Heidy was the lead attorney advising on Sarepta's global expansion efforts.

Prior to joining Sarepta, Heidy was an associate in the Securities and Public Company practice group at Ropes & Gray LLP where she focused her practice on representing public companies in corporate matters including mergers, acquisitions, corporate governance issues, SEC filings and compliance matters, initial public offerings and sales of common stock, bonds, debentures and notes.
