## 2009 ANNUAL REPORT: ACCOMPLISHMENTS

- \* *Moved into an 117,000 square foot building, which allows The Food Bank to nearly double the distribution of food over the next 15 years*
- \* *Distributed 31,497,000 million pounds of food to as many as 545,000 people through our nearly 600 member hunger-relief agencies*
- \* *Increased the overall Nutrition Measurement for our food inventory from 74% to 77% to ensure that a stable supply of healthy food is always available to our member agencies*
- \* *Improved our Volunteer Satisfaction Rating from 4.5 to 4.7 on a 5-point scale, which highlights the wonderful engagement that each person who volunteers experiences*
- \* *Launched a Brown Bag Program in Lawrence, providing a supplemental bag of highly nutritious and desirable grocery products to seniors and families with children*
- \* *Opened our 8th Kids Cafe in South Boston which serves hot meals 5 days a week to 200 underprivileged children*
- \* *Increased outreach to underserved regions so more food pantries, meals programs and shelters can receive food from The Food Bank*



## 2009 ANNUAL REPORT: PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

### Dear Friends,

The Greater Boston Food Bank proudly achieved several important milestones in the fight to end hunger during fiscal year 2009. It was an exceptional year by any measure, and we could not have accomplished all that we did without the help of our many dedicated partners.

Our most visible achievement — and the fulfillment of six long years of planning and construction — was the completion of our new state-of-the-art Yawkey Distribution Center, which enabled us to handle more food at a time when the need for emergency food assistance was rapidly rising.

With detailed strategic planning and strong partner support, we were able to make the move to our new facility with minimal disruption to the flow of food to our member hunger-relief agencies. We also staged a successful Banquet in our new home just a few weeks after the move, and, a few months later, held a ribbon-cutting ceremony that drew distinguished guests such as Boston Mayor Thomas Menino and Senate President Therese Murray.

Among the many features of our new facility are more freezer and cooler space, more dry storage, and the new Roche Family Marketplace, where our member agencies can choose from additional perishable foods when they pick up their food orders.

This additional capacity enabled us to distribute a record-breaking 31.5 million pounds of food during fiscal year 2009, which is a 27 percent increase over the amount of food we distributed just four years ago.

We know that the move to our new facility came just in the nick of time, because the number of people using emergency food assistance in eastern Massachusetts has grown 23 percent in the past four years. This number comes from *Hunger in Eastern Massachusetts 2010*, the most comprehensive study of hunger ever undertaken in our service area. We worked with Feeding America, the nation's food bank network, to compile this information during fiscal year 2009.

Even before the study results were released, we knew that our member agencies were experiencing higher demand for emergency food assistance, with some seeing increases



of 40%. We worked hard throughout the year to help meet this need. In addition to distributing more USDA food made available through the passage of the Farm Bill and the federal stimulus package, we worked with our agencies to help them take better advantage of available resources. This included nearly 2 million pounds of nutritious fruits, vegetables, and other perishable items offered through the Roche Family Marketplace in its first five months of operation.

We also worked with the Patrick Administration, the state legislature, and our many passionate advocates to successfully defend funding for the Massachusetts Emergency Food Assistance Program (MEFAP) several times last year. Thanks to our efforts, MEFAP was reduced by just \$500,000 during a difficult budget period that saw funding for many programs cut dramatically.

We thank our Board of Directors for the strong leadership it provided in fiscal year 2009, and we extend a warm welcome to incoming board Chair Phil Licari. As the head of our Building Committee, he played a key role in making the Yawkey Distribution Center a reality.

We also thank you, our supporters, for helping us achieve so much in fiscal year 2009. We look forward to working with you and engaging new supporters in the years ahead. Hunger is a real and growing problem in eastern Massachusetts, and we know that we need to do even more to ensure that people get the help they need from the emergency food assistance network. We couldn't do what we do without you, and we appreciate the role each of you has chosen to play in the fight to end hunger.

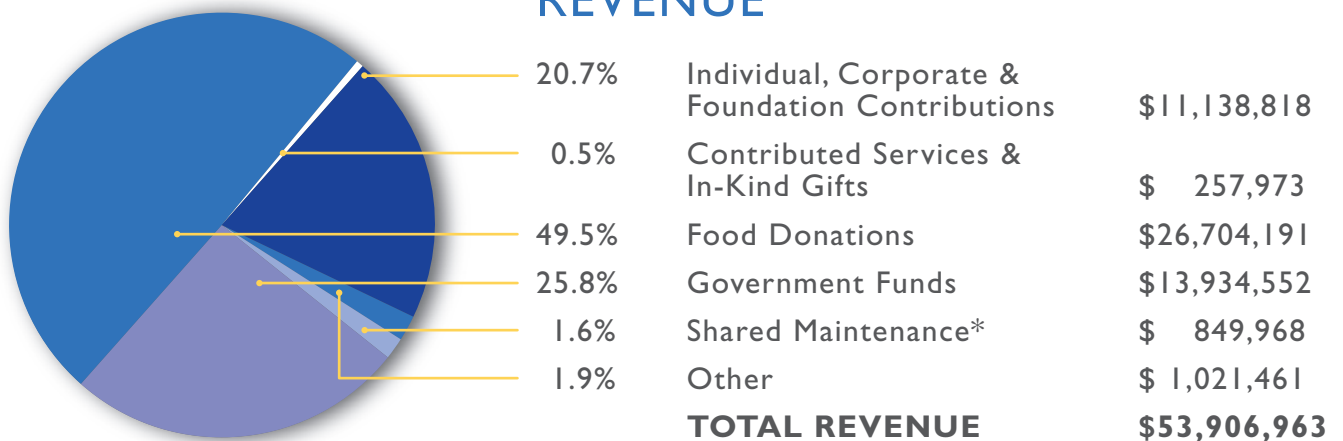

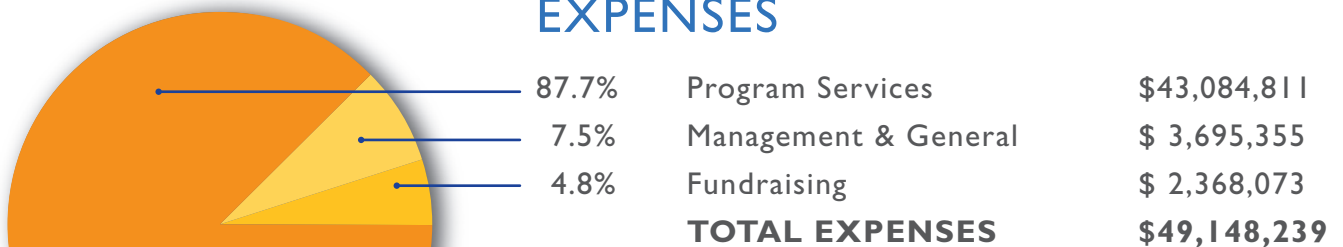
