Laura Perille President & CEO Nurtury Early Education

Laura Perille is President & CEO of Nurtury Early Education, a \$20M childcare nonprofit serving over 1,000 children and families in Greater Boston with high quality early education. Previously, she served as Interim Superintendent of Boston Public Schools, leading the \$1.3B public agency through the 2018-2019 school year. Prior to this appointment, Laura was the founding staff member of EdVestors, a nonprofit school improvement organization where she served as President & CEO from 2002-2018. She has also worked in early education at the multi service agency known as Crittenton Hastings House (now part of EMPath). Laura began her nonprofit career and served as Director of Programs (1989-1994) at the Greater Boston Food Bank.

Currently, Laura serves on the boards of the Massachusetts Association of Early Education & Care (MADCA) and the Greater Boston Food Bank. Laura's public service has included serving as Co-Chair of the BPS Arts Expansion Advisory Board, as a member of the 2012-13 BPS External Advisory Committee on School Choice and Student Assignment, and as an elected member of the National Board of the National Association of Food Rescue. In addition, Laura was an Honorary Professor of Practice, University of Wales-Trinity St. David and a member of the Wales Education Commission, 2016-2018. Laura received a Bachelor of Arts in International Relations from Brown University. She and her family live in Boston. Laura joined the Greater Boston Food Bank Board of Directors in 2019.
