John's research has been published in the *Accounting Review*, the *Journal of Accounting & Economics*, the *Journal of Accounting and Research*, the *Journal of Finance*, and the *Journal of Financial Economics*.

In addition to his research, John teaches the core Financial Accounting class to first-year MBA students at the Sloan School of Management. Prior to his career in academia, he worked in investment banking for Paine Webber and in compensation consulting for Ernst & Young.

John holds a Bachelor of Arts degree from Yale University and a Doctor of Philosophy from The Wharton School of the University of Pennsylvania.
