Sharyn Neble is a philanthropist and community activist in the Greater Boston and Saratoga Springs, New York regions. Sharyn dedicates her time to serving on the board of directors of a variety of human services agencies and organizations dedicated to the rehoming and care of thoroughbred horses.

Sharyn serves on the Board of Directors as Treasurer of Saratoga WarHorse, a nonprofit that connects veterans with retired thoroughbred race horses to aid in treating PTSD. Sharyn joined The Greater Boston Food Bank Emeriti Board in 2018.

Notable past volunteer experiences include serving as Treasurer of the Thoroughbred Aftercare Alliance, Overseer of Lasell College, Trustee of the Boston Public Library Foundation, where she served as Vice Chair and Chair of the Development Committee, and on the Board of Directors of the New England Conservatory Charter School.
