Retired, Director of Research for Professional Services, Fidelity

Norm Lind recently retired from Fidelity Investments where he spent 29 years. The last two years of his career, Norm was on the institutional side of Fidelity, as Director of Research for the Professional Services Group research team. Norm was also Chairman of Fidelity's Product Review Committee.

Norm started at Fidelity as a Fixed Income Analyst and progressed to managing Fidelity's tax-exempt research process while also running the fixed income group's MBA hiring program. After three years in research, Norm became a Fixed Income Portfolio Manager for ten years, followed by a move to the money market desk and a position as Director of Municipal Money Market Portfolio Management. Norm was promoted to the Head of Trading for the firm's money market desk. Much of Norm's time was spent on proposed regulatory changes in Washington, D.C. and with the New York Federal Reserve's short-term financing reforms.

Originally from Seattle, Norm graduated from the University of Washington with a Bachelor's in Business Administration and worked as a CPA with Deloitte Haskins and Sells in Seattle before achieving his Master of Business Administration from Cornell University.
