Member Agencies	GBFB has over 500 member agencies throughout the 190 cities and towns in Eastern Massachusetts. These include food pantries, meal programs and shelters.
Programs	GBFB distributes food directly to those in need through four direct services programs—School-based Pantries, free Mobile Markets and two programs for seniors—at over 80 sites.

Fast Facts	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • GBFB distributed the equivalent of 82 million healthy meals in FY20. • GBFB's distribution has increased by 56% due to the impact of COVID-19. • Feeding America projected that food insecurity in Eastern Massachusetts will increase by 66% so that 1 in 8 people will experience food insecurity. • GBFB provides 80 percent of the food distributed by its over 500 member agencies. • 83 percent of the food GBFB distributes is of the highest-nutritional value; 30 percent is fresh produce; and 53 percent is perishable product (dairy, eggs, meat). • 92 cents of every dollar donated goes directly to hunger-relief efforts.
